
Different Forms of Star Worship

- Modern traditions Daimler's Fairy Witchcraft for example, which focuses on star movement and Otherworld celebrations
- Historical and cultural traditions
- Astronomy based using more scientific notions to fuel your magic
- Figure out what works for you and tweak it to your needs

What counts as a star, anyway?

- Actual stars, obviously (Our Sun included)
- Types of stars to consider Star systems (like Capella, a double binary system), stars on and off the main sequence, pulsars, dwarfs, even whole galaxies
- Not stars but are part of our cosmic landscape Nebulas, black holes, cosmic filaments, fermi bubbles, quasars
- Some folks also use planets to represent specific figures or liminal deities that align with their star worship practice
- Special mention Venus, also called Morning/Evening Star, luminesces by itself
- Cosmic phenomena here on Earth auroras (solar wind), meteor showers, eclipses – or from Earth – JWST, Curiosity, Laika

TECHNIQUES

Remember that you don't need to stay within an astrology framework - there are tons of cool astronomy concepts to bring in

- Pulsars Used in astronomy for timing and coordinates, can be used in magical workings as beacons/lighthouses, anchor points, and precise timekeeping
- Black holes Great for cleansing a space quickly or banishing things to another universe
- Caution It's important to remember the cosmic scale of these things, a little goes a long way

Getting started with workings

- Make sure to keep good records journals, spreadsheets, etc.
- Don't think you can work with the stars? Wrong! We are all made of star stuff!



- Cosmic timescale makes things much more flexible
- Get comfortable with opening the dialogue – many entities are open to communication
- Some star magic may not be useful for earthly matters, but see what sticks

SIGIL BASICS


Basic shapes

- Squares general planes of reality
- Diamonds generally specific locations or personal symbols
- Triangles Elements, can be combined to represent body
- Circles Most stars
- X Either "Eldest Star" or placeholder
- Spirals- directional flow




SIGIL EXAMPLES

- Energy Centers lining up with Star Systems


My personal and group gnosis:
